

The applicant proposes to: **extract sand and gravel, and to establish the post-mining land uses of a wildlife pond and upland grassland wildlife habitat. The proposed mine site covers approximately 50 acres and will be sequentially mined and reclaimed in progressive stages.**

Any person residing within, owning property within, or whose principal place of business is within 300 feet of the boundary of the parcel or parcels of land in which the nonmetallic mining site is located or proposed may request a public informational hearing. Requests for the public informational hearing must be made within 30 days of the publication of this notice.
