

OFFICIAL PUBLIC NOTICE

Nonmetallic Mining Reclamation Plan

Notice is hereby given that the **Chippewa County Highway Dept.** has filed an application to amend a Nonmetallic Mining Reclamation Permit to expand the Quinn site under the Chippewa County Nonmetallic Mining Reclamation Ordinance.

As currently permitted, the mine site covers approximately 14 permitted acres. The applicant proposes a 31 acre expansion of the existing site.

Location: **NW1/4 of NE1/4 and SW1/4 of NE1/4 of Section 25, T31N-R07W**

Owned by: **Chippewa County**

The applicant proposes to: **extract, crush, and wash sand and gravel, and to establish the post-mining land uses as grassland/prairie habitat and shallow ponded/deep ponded habitat. The proposed mine site will expand to cover approximately 44.82 acres and will be sequentially mined and reclaimed in progressive stages.**

Any person residing within, owning property within, or whose principal place of business is within 300 feet of the boundary of the parcel or parcels of land in which the nonmetallic mining site is located or proposed may request a public informational hearing. Requests for the public informational hearing must be made within 30 days of the publication of this notice.
