PUBLIC MEETING MINUTES CHIPPEWA COUNTY HOUSING AUTHORITY (CCHA) ANNUAL 5-YEAR PHA PLAN HEARING MONDAY, DECEMBER 20, 2021 AT 3:30 P.M. ROOM 003 CHIPPEWA COUNTY COURTHOUSE 711 N. BRIDGE ST. CHIPPEWA FALLS, WI 54729

Oleson-Bue called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m.

Attendance: Danielson, Hoffman, Klingenberg, Jankoski, McGill, Oleson-Bue, Patricia Jankoski, and Maree Brown.

Oleson-Bue read through the Authority's goals and objectives from the 5-year PHA plan, and commented on progress made by the PHA in the past year. The goals were reviewed in the following order:

- 1. Expand the supply of affordable housing, especially large unit housing (4 bedroom or larger). Oleson-Bue reviewed the objectives and progress on this goal. Oleson-Bue called for questions and comments; there were none.
- 2. Improve the quality of housing. Oleson-Bue reviewed the objectives and progress on this goal. Jankoski questioned whether the Authority can assist with blighted businesses and stated that this has been done in the past. Oleson-Bue responded that she is unaware of funding that is available to the Authority that would assist businesses. Brown questioned whether a homeowner can maintain ownership of their property when the housing needs to be replaced. Oleson-Bue stated that the Authority looks at the value of the property and cost of repairs when determining if a home can be repaired or needs to be replaced. In the past year, the Authority has completed at least one housing replacement project and the homeowner was in agreement with the plan to replace the housing rather than make the necessary repairs.
- 3. Expand homeownership for low-income families. Oleson-Bue reviewed the objectives and progress on this goal. Jankoski commented that perhaps Rutledge Charities would help fund a YouthBuild program. There were no other comments or questions.
- 4. Provide support to assist homeowners in maintaining homeownership. Oleson-Bue reviewed the objectives and progress on this goal. Oleson-Bue called for questions and comments; there were none.
- 5. Re-establish a Central Point of Intake for Homeless Services in Chippewa County. Oleson-Bue reviewed the objectives and progress on this goal. Brown asked if a homeless shelter will be established in Chippewa County and stated that people are moving here from the Twin Cities, MN to access resources. Discussion included local resources available to Chippewa County residents experiencing homelessness.
- 6. Promote Fair Housing. Oleson-Bue reviewed the objectives and progress on this goal. Jankoski asked if notices are published in local papers throughout the County. Oleson-Bue noted that the Chippewa Herald has been used to publish notices as the County newspaper. Jankoski stated it may be useful to publish in municipal newspapers throughout the County. Brown stated that fair housing information has been distributed by the Chippewa Falls Area Unified School District.

Oleson-Bue thanked those who attended and closed the meeting at 3:59 p.m.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Hoffman called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Members present: Danielson, Hoffman, Jankoski, Kingenberg and McGill

Members absent: None

Others present: Oleson-Bue, Pat Jankoski

3. MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC WISHING TO BE HEARD

None.

4. CONSENT AGENDA

Jankoski and Danielson made a motion to approve the meeting agenda, minutes of the November 15, 2021 meeting as printed, and schedule the next meeting for January 24, 2022 rather than January 24, 2021 as printed. Motion carried with all present voting aye.

5. REPORTS

- 1. 3/31/20 Audit: Oleson-Bue referenced the written report and noted that she has sent correspondence to the HUD field office and has not heard back as of yet. Oleson-Bue stated that she is not concerned, as there were no findings or concerns with the 3/31/20 audit, but it is unusual that the Authority has yet to receive a letter from HUD in acknowledgement of the audit as submitted. Oleson-Bue will provide an update, if available, at the next meeting.
- 2. 3/31/21 Audit Review: Oleson-Bue distributed hard copies of the audit report and stated that this will be placed on the next meeting agenda so the Commissioners have more time to review the report. Oleson-Bue noted that there were no findings and no concerns. Discussion included the Authority's intention to secure a different auditor, and Oleson-Bue stated that she will be conducting procurement for audit services soon.
- **3. B. Burton Retirement:** Oleson-Bue referenced the written report. Discussion included the Authority's practices in honoring retiring staff. Oleson-Bue stated that Burton did not want a large celebration and the Authority staff are planning a small lunch event per Burton's preference.
- 4. Restructuring of Staff Roles Regarding the Section 8 Program, Sunrise Village, and Property Management: Oleson-Bue referenced the written report. Jankoski stated that he has a strong impression of Starks and is in agreement with the plan to increase his role with the Section 8 program rather than having him take on property management of the Authority's rental units. McGill noted that Starks will only have an additional 8 hours each week and may struggle to keep up with Burton's tasks, as Burton has been working 20 hours each week. Oleson-Bue noted that not all of Burton's tasks would be assigned to Starks, but it is possible that a part-time position will be needed in the future to help support the Section 8 program, particularly when full leasing of vouchers is achieved.
- 5. Update on Hope Village: Oleson-Bue referenced the written report. McGill questioned who oversees the general contractor. Oleson-Bue stated that the work will be inspected by the Authority's building inspector, and that the owner will also need to approve any payments that are made to the contractor. Discussion included the prevalence of homelessness in Chippewa County and discussion of available resources.

6. BUSINESS ITEMS

1. Approval of the Financial Reports for November 2021: The written reports were referenced. Hoffman called for questions. Jankoski stated that he would like to see more staff participate in the Deferred

Compensation Program and questioned how the information is presented to the Authority staff. Oleson-Bue stated that a representative provides an overview annually and this has been through a virtual webinar format the last two years due to the COVID 19 pandemic. Klingenberg and McGill made a motion to approve the financial reports for November 2021 as presented. Motion carried with all present voting aye.

2. Authorization to Remove J. Nelson as Primary Admin for the Authority's QuickBooks Software and Replace with J. Oleson-Bue: McGill questioned whether or not a second person could be authorized to perform the same function in the event Oleson-Bue is unavailable. Oleson-Bue stated that she would inquire whether or not that is possible, and if so, the second person would likely need to be authorized through a passed motion at a future meeting. Jankoski and Danielson made a motion to authorize the removal of Julie Nelson as the primary admin for the Authority's QuickBooks software and to replace with Jessica Oleson-Bue as the new primary admin. Motion carried with all present voting aye.

7. AGENDA ITEMS FOR FUTURE CONSIDERATION

Hoffman called for agenda items for future consideration. There were none.

8. ADJOURNMENT

Jankoski and Klingenberg made a motion to adjourn at approximately 4:28 p.m. Motion carried with all present voting aye.

Reports:

- 1. 3/31/20 Audit: I received a response from our HUD representative with the Milwaukee Field Office regarding our 3/31/20 audit which stated "these approval letters are generated from a different department. I have been told there had been a bit of a delay and that they are working on catching up on them." I will update the Commissioners once we receive official notice from HUD regarding our 3/31/20 audit. I do not expect any issues, as there were no findings or concerns with the audit.
- 2. Update on Calendar Year End Activities:
 - a. Homeowner Tax Escrow Accounts: We still have 10 tax escrow accounts to manage for homeowners who have their primary mortgages through the Authority. The 2021 taxes have been paid for these accounts.
 - b. 1099s and 1098s: We are working to input vendor information for 1099s into our Housing Data Systems software which generates a template for uploading into the Yearli website system. We also enter the mortgage interest information into Yearli for 1098 reporting. This is the second year that we have used the Yearli system and the process is very streamlined and user friendly. This system enables us to do electronic submissions to the IRS for the Authority, Clark County Housing Authority, and New Auburn Housing Authority.
 - c. CDBG Single Audit Statements: The State CDBG program requires that municipalities with CDBG funds (active grant or revolving loan funds) provide a statement about the amount of federal funds they disbursed during the last calendar year and whether or not they will be conducting a full audit or not. We have 22 revolving loan programs to monitor and ensure that they have submitted the proper letter signed by their chief elected official on or before the State's deadline.
 - d. CDBG Audit Assistance: Municipalities are preparing for their 2021 audits and most have questions or want confirmation about the CDBG activities for the year, including funds spent and the receivable balances on outstanding loans. Bliss has been working to pull together these reports for each municipality, so that they have the information each year, regardless of whether or not they are having the CDBG funds audited. It will also serve as an annual report to the municipalities on their CDBG revolving loan account.

Business Items:

- 1. Approval of the Financial Reports for December 2021: The December financials are included in the meeting packet.
- 2. Approval of the 3/31/21 Audit: The 3/31/21 audit was passed out at the last meeting. We can discuss the audit and any questions or concerns at this meeting.
- 3. Authorization to Administer City of Rice Lake CDBG Revolving Loan Funds: The City of Rice Lake in Barron County is conducting procurement for a CDBG administrator. I received the RFP and intend to submit a proposal for administration services. The sealed proposals must be received by mail at the City of Rice Lake no later than 1/27/22, so I will be sending out the Authority's proposal prior to the 1/24/22 Commission meeting, but have noted that a

contract would be contingent on Commission approval. The City of Rice Lake has approximately \$425,000.00 in accounts receivable and a current program balance of \$35,000.00 available to spend on rehab or homebuyer projects. Since the Authority already administers the revolving loan fund for Barron County, as well as the Regional grant that serves Barron County, it makes sense for us to administer the City of Rice Lake as well. This would allow continuity of service to homeowners in the City of Rice Lake, as they would be working with our office anyway if the City had no funds available and we would be able to serve them with County or Regional funds. I am proposing the Commissioners approve the administration of the City of Rice Lake's CDBG revolving loan funds. If the City does not select the Authority for administration of their funds, I will notify the Commissioners at a future meeting.
