
Tract 23-22 Maxfield Clearcut: +/-53 acres

Sale Area Description:

The boundaries of this sale are marked with red paint lines. In order to regenerate the timber type this area will be clearcut to promote a coppice of aspen.

Cutting Requirements:

<u>Clear-cut Area:</u> Cut all trees one inch in diameter and larger. **Do not** cut any trees marked with Red (boundary), Yellow (RMZ) or Purple (leave trees) or Red and White pine.

Special Conditions:

- Sale operations are limited to **frozen ground conditions** only.
- No harvesting activity will be allowed if rutting occurs.
- Yellow paint delineates equipment restriction around wetland areas.
- Timbers mats may be required, the County has mats available on a first-come first-served basis.
- All logging debris must remain within the sale boundaries and kept from wetlands, lakes and trails.
- All recreational trails shall remain passable to users and free of slash during sale operations.
- All landing locations must be approved. All merchantable timber that is removed along landings or skid trails must be utilized and accounted for through mill slips or log scales.
- Leave all snags (dead trees) unless they present a safety hazard. Use caution to limit the disturbance of Course Woody Debris (CWD) on the forest floor. (ie) down logs greater than 12 inches in diameter.
- All hardwood logs, (except aspen) 10" or larger on the small end will be charged at the appropriate saw log stumpage rate.
- The contract length is approximately 1.5 years, including 2 winter season, ending March 31, 2024.
