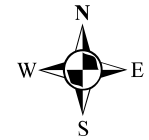

Total Sale Area: (approximately 48 acres)

Located in T32N R5W Section 25, Town of Ruby

The table below contains an estimate of the amount of each species/product. There is no minimum bid for each species; however **the total minimum bid that is acceptable for Tract 16-23 is \$ 22,772.00**

Sale Area Description:

The boundaries of this sale are marked with red and blue paint lines along property lines. This sale is 48 acres of white spruce plantation/ aspen clear-cut. The goal of this harvest is to transition these stands to aspen by cutting all spruce and mature hardwood. There are existing landings in the sale area but many will need ditch work to access the landings. This sale will be restricted to frozen ground access only.

Cutting Requirements:

Clear Cut area: (48 acres) Cut all trees 2" or greater. Do not cut oak or white pine, sale boundary trees (red or blue paint) or trees that are marked with yellow paint to identify riparian management zones and wetlands. Minimize damage to small diameter trees.

Special Conditions:

- Frozen ground conditions required
- No harvesting activity will be allowed if rutting occurs.
- No equipment operation is allowed within wetland areas delineated by yellow paint.
- All logging debris must remain within the sale boundaries and kept from wetlands, lakes and trails.
- All landing locations must be approved. All merchantable timber that is removed along landings or skid trails must be utilized and accounted for through mill slips or log scales.
- *Leave all snags (dead trees) unless they present a safety hazard. Use caution to limit the disturbance of Course Woody Debris (CWD) on the forest floor. (ie) down logs greater than 12 inches in diameter.*
- All cordwood shall be utilized to a 4" top diameter.
- All hardwood logs, (except aspen) 10" or larger on the small end will be charged at the appropriate saw log stumpage rate.
- The contract length is two years.
