PUBLIC MEETING MINUTES CHIPPEWA COUNTY HOUSING AUTHORITY (CCHA) MONDAY, OCTOBER 23, 2023 AT 3:30 P.M. ROOM 016 OF THE CHIPPEWA COUNTY COURTHOUSE

1. CALL TO ORDER

Hull called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Members present: Davis, Hull, Jankoski, and McGill

Members absent: Danielson Others present: Oleson-Bue

3. MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC WISHING TO BE HEARD

None.

4. CONSENT AGENDA

McGill and Jankoski made a motion to approve the meeting agenda, minutes of the September 18, 2023 meeting as printed, and schedule the next meeting for December 11, 2023. Motion carried with all present voting aye.

5. REPORTS

- 1. Informal Hearings for Rental Assistance Programs: No addition to the written report.
- **2. J. Davis Appointment:** The commissioners welcomed Judith Davis to the Housing Commission and completed introductions. Hull thanked Davis for her interest in serving on the Commission.
- 3. Update on Habitat for Humanity Partnership for New Construction: No addition to the written report.
- **4. Update on 17 W. Birch St. Chippewa Falls:** Oleson-Bue referenced the written report and described the changes to the floor plan of the home to create a fifth bedroom and second full bathroom. Oleson-Bue stated that the property will be a good addition to the Authority's rental portfolio.
- **5. Update on New Construction Duplex:** Oleson-Bue referenced the written report and provided additional details on the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) funds that were used toward the development cost. Oleson-Bue noted that the income limits for the NSP funds are 120% of the County Median Income, which is a higher income limit than other programs administered by the Authority. Oleson-Bue stated that the units are three-bedrooms, and are expected to be available for leasing on January 1, 2024.
- **6.** Update on 209 N. 6th St. Cornell: In addition to the written report, Oleson-Bue stated that all work by the general contractor has been completed, but there are still some miscellaneous items that are being completed by the Authority's maintenance staff before the home will be listed for sale.
- 7. Update on 334 E. 2nd Ave. Stanley: Oleson-Bue referenced the written report. Jankoski stated that he was surprised that the home needed more repairs than he had expected, as listed in the written report.
- 8. Update on 738 Maple St. Chippewa Falls: No addition to the written report.
- 9. Review of the Draft 5-Year PHA Plan: Oleson-Bue referenced the written report and stated that no Housing Choice Voucher participants attended the listening session that was held on 10/19/23. Oleson-Bue called for comments or additions to the draft plan. Davis inquired whether the Authority had any housing development projects in Bloomer and stated that there are more than thirty students in the Bloomer School District who are classified as homeless. Davis went on to state that new construction housing in Bloomer is not affordable for many. Oleson-Bue responded that the Authority owns one rental property in Bloomer, but does not currently have any special housing projects or developments in that area. Oleson-Bue noted that the 5-Year PHA Plan goals and objectives are applicable to all areas of the County. Jankoski stated that he has been pleased to see the Authority complete housing projects in various municipalities throughout the County in recent years.

10. Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher Program Updates: Oleson-Bue referenced the written report and stated that she has conducted procurement for an inspector using the NSPIRE standards, and that the Authority received two bids, with Andy Clay being the low bidder. Oleson-Bue discussed the delayed implementation of NSPIRE inspections with Clay and he has agreed to begin conducting NSPIRE inspections on 10/1/24. Oleson-Bue provided a brief overview of the HOTMA provisions, eVMS transition, and HIP software conversion.

6. **BUSINESS ITEMS**

- 1. Approval of the Financial Reports for September 2023: Hull called for questions. There were none. Oleson-Bue referenced the profit and loss statement and noted that the salary and benefit expenses are lower than budgeted because the expense was offset by two months of salary and benefit reimbursements from the Section 8 program that were deposited in September. McGill and Jankoski made a motion to approve the financial reports for September 2023 as printed. Motion carried with all present voting aye.
- 2. Group Health Insurance Employer Contribution Rate: Oleson-Bue referenced the written report and stated that the Authority needs to make a change in how the employer contribution rate is calculated for the group health insurance. Oleson-Bue stated that the Authority can set the employer contribution rate between 50% and 88% of the average qualified plans for all employees working 1,044 hours or more. Oleson-Bue further stated that for insured employees working less than 1,044 hours per year, the Authority must contribute not less than 25% of the lowest qualified plan. Oleson-Bue proposed the following employer calculations: 88% of average qualified plans for full time employees, 69% of average qualified plans for 3/4 time employees, 50% of average qualified plans for half time employees, and 25% of the lowest qualified plan for employees who work less than 20 hours per week. Oleson-Bue stated that each of the Authority's current employees are full time, and that over the last five years, the Authority's contribution rate has averaged about 83% of the average qualified plans. Jankoski stated that the Authority has strong staff members and that he is in favor of the employer contribution rate as presented. McGill questioned whether the budget could support the increased cost, and Oleson-Bue responded that she feels confident that the Authority can support the increased cost for 2024, but noted that the rates change each year and tend to increase. Hull questioned whether employees are compensated if they do not participate in the group health insurance and Oleson-Bue responded that they are not. Jankoski inquired about the annual cost for fringe benefits and Oleson-Bue provided the information. McGill and Jankoski made a motion to approve the employer contribution rates for group health insurance as presented. Motion carried with all present voting aye.

7. AGENDA ITEMS FOR FUTURE CONSIDERATION

Hull called for agenda items for future consideration. Jankoski stated that he would like to have more information on the Authority's role in assisting municipalities with demolition projects, as noted in the draft 5-Year PHA Plan.

8. ADJOURNMENT

Jankoski and McGill made a motion to adjourn at 4:23 p.m. Motion carried with all present voting aye.

Reports:

- 1. Informal Hearings for Rental Assistance Programs: There were no informal hearings conducted since the last meeting, and no new requests for a hearing.
- 2. Update on 209 N. 6th St. Cornell: Our maintenance staff, Rick, is working on some final miscellaneous repair items and will have all work completed this week. I am collecting all final invoices for this property and I will work with Bliss to determine the total amount of funding the Authority needs to recoup with the sale of this property. Within the next week or two, we will get the property listed for sale with our realtor. The property must be sold to a family at or below 80% of the County Median Income level, and the Authority can provide down payment assistance in the form of a zero interest, deferred payment loan which reduces the amount the buyer has to borrow from a traditional lender, making the monthly payments more affordable.
- 3. L. Artz Retirement: Lori has given notice of her retirement, and her last day of employment will be February 9th, 2024. Lori has been employed with the Authority for twenty years and has extensive knowledge and experience with many programs operated by the Authority, particularly the CDBG program. Lori indicated plans to retire well in advance and has been spending a great deal of time over the past couple of years training other staff members to ensure a smooth transition. Lori has been a tremendous asset to the Authority and she will be greatly missed. I am not intending to fill the position. We historically had three CDBG Rehabilitation Specialists but added a fourth (Bobbie) back in September 2019 because the other three (Bruce, Valerie, and Lori) were all heading toward retirement and we wanted to prepare well in advance to have new staff train with our longstanding staff since the CDBG program can be complicated to administer. When Lori retires, we will be back to three CDBG Rehabilitation Specialists instead of four, and we will monitor over the next six months to one year to ensure the remaining staff are able to meet the CDBG grant contract spending goals. We have been using our new Neighborly software since March 2023 to administer the CDBG program. The staff are becoming more comfortable with the software and noticing many areas where the software helps improve efficiency.
- 4. 3/31/23 Audit: Bliss and I have been providing additional information to the auditors as they work to finalize the 3/31/23 audit. The audited financial report must be submitted to HUD no later than 12/31/23. I expect to have copies of the audit available to distribute with the January meeting packet.

Business Items:

- 1. Approval of the Financial Reports for October 2023: The October financials are included in the meeting packet.
- 2. L. Artz Retirement Gift: I am looking for authorization to purchase a retirement gift for Lori. When Valerie retired in February 2023, the Authority purchased flowers and a \$100 gift certificate.
