(Step 1) NIGHT BEFORE: Freeze water bottles or make ice for transportation of sample.



(Step 2) Find a sampling tap to draw water sample from. If a water treatment system is present, sample at the nearest tap after the system. A kitchen tap or well sample tap may also be used, Do NOT use an outside tap.



(Step 3) Remove any screen, filter, or other attachments that may be on the faucet. If the faucet does not hold a steady stream find a different tap.





(Step 4) Remove the sample bottle cap without touching the inside of the cap or bottle.



(Step 5) Run the cold water at pencil width for at least <u>5</u> minutes before collecting samples.



(Step 6) Fill bottle to the shoulder of the bottle. Replace cap securely and write your name on the side of bottle and fill out other side of this form.



(Step 7) Pack sample in a cooler or other container with ice for transportation.

Do not use ice packs



(Step 8) Bring the water sample to Chippewa County Health Dept. on the first floor of the Chippewa County Government Center in Chippewa Falls.
