

<p>WI DNR Beach Water Standards</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If the <i>E. coli</i> count is greater than 1,000 MPN/100 mL, the beach is unsafe for swimming. • If the <i>E. coli</i> count is greater than 235 MPN/100 mL but less than 1,000 MPN/100 mL, swim at your own risk. • If the <i>E. coli</i> count is under 235 MPN/100 mL, enjoy the water. <p>https://dnr.wisconsin.gov/topic/Beaches</p>	<p>(Step 1)</p> <p>Enter the body of water to be tested in roughly the center of the beach/water area to be tested to knee depth (24-30 inches deep).</p> <p>Take care not to stir up the bottom sediment while walking out.</p>
<p>(Step 2)</p> <p>Uncap bottle and plunge the bottle mouth first straight into the water to a depth of 6-12 inches. Tip bottle to allow captured air to release and water to enter.</p> <p>If current is present face the bottle into the current and away from your hand.</p> <p>Fill bottle completely.</p>	<p>(Step 3)</p> <p>Remove bottle from water. Dump excess water out of the sample.</p> <p><i>Fill with at least 100ml (to the line), but do not fill into the neck of the bottle.</i></p>
<p>(Step 4)</p> <p>Replace cap securely and write your name on the side of bottle and fill out other side of this form. Leave 1" headroom (air) at the top of the bottle.</p>	<p>(Step 5)</p> <p>Bring the water sample and completed sample form to Chippewa County Public Health on the first floor of the Government Center in Chippewa Falls, East entrance.</p> <p><u>We will NOT accept a sample on Thursday after 11:30 or Friday.</u></p>
