This bottle contains very corrosive nitric acid. DO NOT rinse bottle

FOR LEAD TESTING ONLY:

In order to determine whether the water is leaching lead from the solder joints, collect the sample in the morning before anyone has drawn water. The water should remain in the plumbing 6-12 hours before collecting the sample. This is a "first draw" sample. Use a faucet which you would normally obtain drinking water or water for cooking.

SAMPLING INSTRUCTIONS FOR LEAD AND/OR ARSENIC ANALYSIS

- 1. Do not use the pressure tank sampling tap, outside tap or laundry tub faucet.
- 2. Place the sample bottle under the faucet and slowly turn on cold water. DO NOT rinse the bottle.
- 3. Collect enough water to fill the bottle within 1 inch of the top. Do not fill the bottle to overflowing. Replace the cover and tighten firmly.
- 4. Complete the lab test request form. Remember to fill in collection date and time and mark desired test.
- 5. Bring sample back to the Chippewa County Department of Public Health office.
