## Items Accepted

Prescription and over-the-counter medications may be disposed of in a permanent drug drop box, including:

- Capsules
- Creams
- Inhalers
- Non-aerosol sprays
- Ointments
- Patches
- Pills
- Vials

 Pet medications

 Liquids must be in their original container

 Vape pens/e-cigarette devices with batteries removed

## Items Not Accepted

- ✗ Aerosol cans
- ✗ Anything containing blood or bodily fluid
- ✗ Household hazardous waste (paint, pesticides, oil, gas)
- ✗ Illegal drugs
- ✗ Iodine-containing medications
- ✗ Mercury thermometers
- ✗ Personal care products (shampoo, soaps, lotions, sunscreens, etc.)
- ✗ Sharps/syringes
- ✗ Vape pens/e-cigarette devices with a built-in battery that cannot be removed
