Nonmetallic Mining Reclamation Plan

Notice is hereby given that **Haas Sons, Inc.** has filed an application for a Nonmetallic Mining Reclamation Permit with the Chippewa County Department of Land Conservation & Forest Management under the Chippewa County Nonmetallic Mining Reclamation Ordinance.

Location: **SW ¼ of Section 35, T29N-R07W**
Owned by: **Shey Peterson**

The applicant proposes to: **extract, crush, and wash sand and gravel, and to establish the post-mining land use as a wildlife pond and upland grassland wildlife habitat. The proposed mine site covers approximately 40.8 acres and will be sequentially mined and reclaimed in progressive stages.**

Any person residing within, owning property within, or whose principal place of business is within 300 feet of the boundary of the parcel or parcels of land in which the nonmetallic mining site is located or proposed may request a public informational hearing. Requests for the public informational hearing must be made within 30 days of the publication of this notice.
